Cost: \$2,500

Included: All air and ground transportation, meals, lodging, entrance fees to cultural sites

We will also be visiting major Cambodian cultural sites, such as Angkor Wat, Tuol Sleng Prison and the Killing Fields, Phnom Phen Markets, and more. We will also experience worship with a local Cambodian church, as well as a church dedication.
